YOUR UNIVERSITY

A little history

Panthéon-Assas University is the successor of the former Paris Law and Economics School, a part of the Sorbonne, and is located in the heart of the Latin Quarter since the 13th century. The Assas Centre on rue d'Assas, built in the early 1960s, and the Panthéon Campus, located near its headquarters, give the university its name.

Since 1 January 2022, Paris-Panthéon-Assas University has become an experimental public institution and includes 4 private "grandes écoles" recognised as being of general interest: <u>EFREI, ISIT, CFJ, École W</u>. The first university to be based on a public-private partnership, its ambition is to accompany and support transformations in the contemporary world as a leading higher education and research institution.

University bodies

The University is headed by a President, elected by the members of the Board of Governors for a four-year term, renewable once. The University's policy is shaped by its central councils:

- The Board of Directors votes on the budget and determines the institution's policies;
- The Research Council defines the principles governing the implementation of the University's research and innovation policies;
- The council for studies and student life defines the conditions for implementing academic courses and the principles of university life.

The Learning Centre

An open-plan space for experience and innovation, the *Learning Centre*, located in the Assas centre, includes an open-space library, individual and collective work spaces, restaurants, rapid access to new technologies and a sports hall in a pleasant and comfortable setting. On enrolment, the University will give you an email address in the format: firstname.surname@etudiants.u-paris2.fr.

IMPORTANT!

You must check your student email regularly. It is the only email address that the University will use to communicate with you.

Once you're connected to <u>ent.u-paris2.fr</u>, you can access your virtual workspace consisting of:

- Your email inbox and your calendar, which can also be synced with your smart phone;
- The administrative, student and lecturer directory;
- Teaching resources, which give you access to podcasts, online video lectures and Agor@ssas;
- Documentary resources giving you access to the digital library (books and online journals), plagiarism prevention and text correction software and the University's theses;
- The professional employment space which gives you access to the Réseau Pro platform (internship offers, jobs, etc.).

WiFi

There are many WiFi access points (wifi_paris2) in the Assas, Charcot, Desgoffe, Fossés Saint-Jacques, Melun, Panthéon, Saint-Jacques, Ulm, Vaugirard 1, Vaugirard 2 and Val de Grâce centres. With your email credentials, you can connect to WiFi via the national Eduspot network (<u>services.renater.fr/documentation/eduspot/index</u>) and the international Eduroam network (<u>www.eduroam.fr</u>).

YOUR STUDENT CARD

A multi-service card which allows students to:

- Prove your student status, as you must present it to access the university buildings and libraries of the Panthéon-Assas University, borrow documents, benefit from discounts (transport, cinemas, swimming pools, municipal theatres, etc.);
- Pay for your meals in the CROUS restaurants or cafeterias;
- Pay for printing and photocopying in our libraries;
- Reserve work rooms at the Assas Centre;
- Access the sports hall at the Assas Centre (subject to registration with the sports service);
- ✓ Borrow laptops and tablets from the library for on-site use in the Learning Centre at the Assas Centre or in the Vaugirard 1 and Melun centres;
- Access the University's component institutions: EFREI, ISIT, CFJ, École W.

A card valid throughout your time at the University

Once you have the card, go to <u>www.izly.fr</u> to activate your IZLY account. You can reload your card:

- Via transfers to your account on <u>www.izly.fr</u>;
- In cash in CROUS university restaurants.

The Panthéon-Assas University is not responsible for the amount on your IZLY account: any reissue of a new card will be at your expense.
