Upon reception of your application, you will receive a response from the university's admission committee within 15 days.

4. Confirm your seat: pay the tuition fees deposit

This payment should be made within 3 weeks following the receipt of the Acceptance Letter. Please refer to the Fees Planning document for details on the payment plan.
